ACCESS

We believe that theatre is for everyone and we want to make sure you have a comfortable visit. Here are just some of the things we're doing to make the Marina accessible.



WHEELCHAIRS AND MOBILITY AIDS

We are proud to be fully wheelchair accessible including dedicated access toilets on all three levels. For most shows we have up to 14 wheelchair spaces available which can come with companion seats if required. 12 of these are in the stalls and 2 are in the circle which is accessible via our lift. We can make wheelchair accessible spaces in Row A, G and N in the stalls. These are available on a first come, first served basis so please call our Box Office on 01502 533200 to book.

HEARING ASSISTANCE

We have a Sennheiser infrared hearing system. The system allows sound from the stage to be played back to you through headphones or hearing aids via an easy-to-use bodypack. Any headphones with a 3.5mm jack plug can be used with the bodypack. You are welcome to bring your own set, or you can purchase them from the kiosk.

SUBTITLED SCREENINGS

Subject to availability we will programme subtitled films. These show the dialogue and other heard elements of a film at the bottom of the screen and are really useful for people who are deaf, hard of hearing or speak English as a second language.

ACCESSIBLE PERFORMANCES

For this years pantomime, Snow White, we're thrilled to offer a signed performance, a relaxed performance, and a signed and relaxed performance. More details can be found on our pantomime page at the back of this brochure.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

At the time of printing there are a limited amount of accessible parking spaces available at the side of Savers on The Marina for drivers with a blue badge.

GETTING HERE

While we don't have on-site parking, there are several convenient car parks just a short walk away, with free parking available after 6pm. For long-stay parking before 6pm, we recommend Whapload Road car park. Additional options can be found near Lowestoft Library.

We're an 8-minute walk from Lowestoft Train Station, with direct services from Ipswich and Norwich.

Lowestoft Bus Station is just 5 minutes away, offering connections to Beccles, Norwich, Southwold, and nearby villages. For more info visit: firstgroup.com
